

## Coach charged with molesting four boys

A SEPAK takraw coach was charged in a district court yesterday with molesting four teenage boys and performing oral sex on one of them.

The 50-year-old, whose name is withheld to protect the victims' identities, is claiming trial to six charges.

He allegedly molested his victims, aged 13 and 14, on various occasions between October 2006 and June 2007.

The man, represented by

Mr Ignatius Joseph, is said to have committed unnatural sex on a 14-year-old boy in a toilet in April 2007, two months after allegedly molesting him in a car.

Bail of \$10,000 was set. The case has been adjourned to March 9.

If found guilty of molestation, he can be jailed for up to two years and/or fined.

The maximum punishment for unnatural sex is life imprisonment or up to 10 years in jail and a fine.
